DUTIES OF THE POSITION

The student assistant will work under the direction of the Principal Investigator (PI) Dr. Matthew Clark to support research on various grants. Computer work will be done in the Center for Interdisciplinary Geospatial Analysis (CIGA) at Sonoma State. Duties include: using GIS to digitize polygons; satellite and drone image analysis; processing of lidar data to quantify forest structure; ecoacoustic species analysis; field work to validate remote sensing analysis and models.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

The ability to learn and perform assigned work; work cooperatively with faculty, staff, and other students; and accept responsibility. Completion of specific coursework may be required in order to teach, grade, complete research, or tutor for a course. Admission or registration as a University student. Note: Exceptions to the minimum eligibility qualifications may be granted at the sole discretion of the University.

HIRING CRITERIA

Knowledge of remote sensing and GIS use and methods. Ability to work independently and in a team to accomplish assigned tasks with efficiency and speed, while maintaining scientific rigor. Organized, communicative and motivated to acquire new skills and knowledge. Computer programming in R or python and field work experience desired.
