Procedures for Lecturer Range Elevation Department of Engineering Science February 2015

The Department of Engineering Science follows the University's guidelines, http://www.sonoma.edu/uaffairs/policies/range.htm, for evaluating lecturer range elevation.

In summary, as part of the application, the candidate will provide:

- 1. a narrative statement of his/her professional growth and development (see list of possible activities in section III.A of the policy),
- 2. current curriculum vitae,
- 3. a summary of the candidate's work assignments for each semester of the period under consideration, and
- 4. student evaluation summaries for all evaluated courses taught by the candidate in the department during the period of evaluation.

In addition, the ES Department may conduct classroom observations by tenure/tenure-track faculty members as part of the evaluation.

The recommendation will be made by the ES Department chair to the dean.
